Your Study Programme

All our study programmes are tailored to the student's individual needs and abilities.

Vocational Programmes

These programmes are available at Entry Level 1, 2 and 3. They are vocational qualifications, which will prepare you for further study or employment related to a specific area of work. They have an emphasis on developing practical and creative skills. Employers really value the skills you will develop on a vocational course and Level 3 courses are also an ideal qualification for entry to university.

Apprenticeships

Apprentices learn on the job, building up knowledge and skills, gaining qualifications and earning a salary all at the same time. Apprenticeships are perfect if you are eager to earn straight away or already have an employer who will take you on as an Apprentice. You must have the potential to achieve Level 2 and/ or Level 3 and to achieve further qualifications in Mathematics and English. You will be working for an employer, earning a wage and depending on your chosen career area, you will study at College on a block or day release basis.

English and Maths

Croydon College ensures all students have an appropriate level in English and Maths. For those students that haven't achieved a GCSE grade 4 or above, or an equivalent qualification, will have dedicated timetabled sessions and will be working towards achieving an appropriate qualification in English and Maths. Entry Requirements

Applications are invited from everyone. We enrol students based on academic merit and potential irrespective of educational background.

Level 1

Students need to show evidence of a commitment to learn and the ability to study at this level, at the interview stage.

English and Maths assessed at Entry Level 2 or above.

Level 2

A minimum of 3 GCSEs at grade 3 (or grade D), including English or a Level 1 related qualification.

Mathematics assessed at Entry Level 3 or above.

Level 3

A minimum of 4 GCSEs grade 4 (or grade C) or higher, one being English or Maths or a related Level 2 vocational course at Merit or higher (if a Pass grade is achieved, GCSE grades and/or Functional Skills results can also be considered).

English and Maths assessed at Level 1 or above.

Facilities, Resources and Pastoral

Library and Learning Centre

Our state-of-the-art Library and Learning Centre offers a space to complete assignments with all the relevant information at your fingertips. Study Plus Learning

In addition to offering Maths and English support, we also run a successful homework club for all students. We also offer one-to-one and small group support to students with learning needs.

Careers Centre

Advanced Learning Loans

Students aged 19 and over can apply for Advanced Learning Loans to help pay for Level 3, 4 and 5 course fees. If you are successful for an Advanced Learning Loan, you will not need to pay anything back until you are earning over £25,000.

The Advanced Learning Loans are not means tested or credit checked and you can apply whether you are in employment, in receipt of Job Seekers Allowance (JSA) or Employment Support Allowance (ESA). The Ioan will be paid directly to Croydon College on your behalf. You can apply on line at www.gov.uk/advanced-learner-Ioan

Please call our Finance Department on 020 8686 5700 who can help you with your application form and answer any questions you may have.

To qualify for an Advanced Learning Loan you need to be:

- Aged 19 or over on the date you start your course
- You must usually be a permanent resident in the UK for three years prior to the start of the course
- Enrolling on an eligible Level 3, Level 4 or Level 5 course including: Vocational courses and Access to HE Diploma

We offer a generic Level 1 course which gives you the basic skills for many of our Level 2 courses.

Level 1 Progression to your chosen Level 2

Course Content

The Level 1 Introductory Certificate prepares students to improve their knowledge and study skills that will then enable them to undertake study at Level 2 in a subject area of their choice. The course combines some practical activities as well as theory to give students an overview of a wide range of subjects allowing them to build on their study skills and gain important knowledge that will help them be successful in their chosen study or careers.

Art & Design and Fashion

Art & Design

These creative courses will offer you the opportunity to work with a wide range of art and design materials, techniques, and processes in our subject specialist studios and workshops. Exploring a wide variety of hands-on creative subjects that will develop and build on your natural artistic abilities. You will undertake a range of projects that include, and combine, photography, drawing, sculpture, three-dimensional design, printmaking, textiles and surface design, graphic visual communication, illustration, and painting.

Taught by art and design specialists, you are encouraged to take an experimental and open minded approach to exploring ideas which challenge and develop creative thinking and making skills. Guided by your tutor, you will grow in confidence and will develop the skills to achieve your potential.

We have great facilities here at Croydon School of Art; photographic dark rooms, print studio, plaster casting studio, 3D workshop, film studio, drawing studio, many Mac suites, and video and film editing facilities with great technical support.

Please note that the college will provide some materials and equipment whilst you study. However, there is an expectation of additional material costs of approximately £30 per term. Day trips to galleries and other places of interest usually cost between £25-30 within the year. You may be eligible for a bursary and this should cover the cost of equipment.

Fashion

This course is aimed at those students who will thrive on being challenged creatively as it will develop your skills in research, design development, pattern making, and garment construction. You will grow as a designer, illustrator, pattern cutter, and machinist. You will receive weekly feedback from staff and peers, with more formal feedback given at the end of each project. This allows you to receive positive and constructive advice on your work throughout the project. You will also have a clear understanding of meeting deadlines and expectations.

Working in a creative and inclusive environment, our excellent facilities include our purpose built fashion studios, and our excellent resources that will support your learning and develop your understanding of fashion design, print, and textiles. You will work and collaborate with our experienced staff who have the relevant skills and connections to the industry to help you achieve your potential.

Construction and Building Services

These courses will provide you with the basic skills and understanding needed to work in the construction industry. You will learn introduction to a variety of skills including brickwork. plastering, woodwork, painting and decorating, and tiling, as well as an introduction to the background knowledge required to succeed. All of these skills are in demand in the industry so you can decide which construction route suits you best.

Maintenance

This course will provide you with the practical skills as well as the knowledge and understanding of construction to allow you to pursue a career in this industry. You will learn the basics of how buildings are constructed and how to recognise the common defects in different parts of a building. You will be able to treat and repair these defects to industry standards.

Throughout this course you will study a range of subjects, including repairs, diagnosing defects, wall construction, developing customer relations, and health and safety practices.

Construction

The Level 3 Extended Diploma is designed for those who wish to work in the construction industry as a manager or professional worker in the field of site research, site management, cost control, or building design. This course is mainly theory based and it will develop the skills that you will have learnt on a Level 2 course.

This course is for learners who want to work as plumbers in the building services engineering sector. This gualification does **not** make candidates fully qualified plumbers but will allow you to learn, develop and practise the skills required for progression in the plumbing sector. It covers subject such as; Hot and Cold water systems, Common plumbing processes, Central heating systems, Drainage systems and Electrical principles and processes.

Engineering

Engineering

This course is designed for those who have an interest in engineering. with a desire to have a career within this sector. We will provide you with the practical experience and the technical knowledge to work in the engineering industry. Each level builds on the knowledge and skillset vou learnt in a previous level. You will learn the basic fundamentals of mechanical engineering through a combination of theory lessons and practical work in our contemporary engineering workshops.

During the Level 1 course you will study a range of subjects, including wiring electrical circuits, making engineering components, interpreting and using engineering information, using the bench drill, health and safety practices, and various employability units.

Throughout the Level 2 course you will study a wide range of subjects, including engineering marking out, interpreting and using engineering information, using CAD, casting and moulding, and health and safety practices.

On Level 3, you will study nine units each in both the first year and the second year. This will cover a range of subjects, including mechanical/ electrical principles, mechanical systems and measurements. engineering drawing/design, CAD, fluid dynamics, and health and safety practices.

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Electrotechnical Technology

This course will expand your knowledge and skills in order to work in the electrical installation industry. You will learn the intermediate skills of electrotechnical technology through the combination of theory lessons and practical work in our modern, well-equipped workshops. The course will also develop your confidence to conduct repairs and carry out fault finding on electrical circuitry.

Throughout this course you will study a range of subjects, including testing dead circuits, safe isolation procedures, comprehensive metal working skills, and conduit and trunking.

As a part of your study programme you will also improve vour English, maths and employability skills - all of these are vital if you plan to get a job, live independently or progress onto another college course

ESOL - English for Progression/English for Speakers of Other Languages

This course is for you if you speak English as a second or other language. The course will help you if you have had a few years at secondary school or are have been in the UK for a short time.
