

Coronavirus information for new starters in September 2020

We continue to follow Government guidance in relation to the Coronavirus pandemic. Our main concern is keeping our students and staff safe whilst adhering to social distancing measures. However, it is difficult to predict when or how guidance may change and so planning for September delivery is based on current guidelines. We will of course update all of our current students and offer holders as soon as reasonably possible when and how lectures will be delivered come September.

For now, it is anticipated that all our university courses will be delivered through a blended approach which will consist of some on-campus delivery and some online teaching. The ratios of this will depend on individual courses due to cohort sizes. We will advise of any changes as soon as reasonably possible following Government advice and guidance.

Please note teaching for the Autumn Term (Semester 1) of 2020/21 academic year commences the week of 14 September 2020.
