### **MINIMUM ENTRY CRITERIA FOR ALL COURSES**

### **Croydon College**

### Level 3 programme BTEC

Four GCSE's at grades 9-4/A\*-C; or a related Level 2 vocational course at merit or higher (if a pass grade is achieved GCSE grades and/or functional skills results may also be considered); and GCSE at grade 9-4/A\*-C (or equivalent) in English or Mathematics; or English and Mathematics assessed at Level 1 or above by college assessment.

### Level 2 programme

Three GCSE's at grades 3/D; or a related Level 1 vocational qualification; and a GCSE at grade 3/D (or equivalent) in English; or English and Mathematics assessed at Entry 3 or above by college assessment.

#### Level 1 programme

Evidence of a commitment to learn and the ability to study at this Level shown at interview; and English and Mathematics assessed at Entry 2 or above by college assessment.

#### Entry & pre-entry programme

No formal entry requirements. We test your abilities before you start and place you on the course that best fits the skills you already have; and you must show at interview that you are committed to full time studies and keen to develop all of your work skills, not just your English.

Mature applicants may also be considered via an interview based on rele ent experien Other gualifications not listed above may be accepted upo red— a satisfactory reference may be required in some instance

Applicants for the access to teacher training course must also have gcse science (for unconditional) or be studying it for a conditional offer



### UNIVERSITY CENTRE CROYDON ENTRY CRITERIA SEPTEMBER 2020

#### Higher Education: Honours degree programmes

A minimum of 80 UCAS points from the following: A-Level or other equivalent advanced Level; or BTEC qualification in a related subject; or a pass in a relevant ACCESS course; or other recognised overseas Level 3 qualification and a pass in English language at GCSE at grade C/4 or above; or IELTS test at band 6.0 or above with a minimum overall score of 6.0 with a minimum of 6.0 in reading and writing and 5.5 in speaking and listening.

#### Higher Education: Foundation degree programmes

A minimum of 48 UCAS points from: A-Level or other equivalent advanced Level; or BTEC qualification in a related subject; or a pass in a relevant ACCESS course; or other recognised overseas Level 3 qualification and a pass in English language at GCSE at grade C/4 or above; or IELTS test at band 6.0 or above with a minimum overall score of 6.0 with a minimum of 6.0 in reading and writing and 5.5 in speaking and listening.





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
