Priority Early Enrolment

All students who have passed their year of study and who are progressing to Year 2 or 3 of their programme will be able to enrol earlier and online. You will receive instructions on how to do this via your College email account, please check this to ensure you don't miss out. Students who are **resubmitting work over the summer** will be notified of their results after the External Assessment Board on 04/09/20 and will be able to enrol the subsequent week.

Enrolment for all new entrants (Year 1) and resubmitting students is scheduled from Wednesday 9th September 2020 to Friday 11th September 2020. You will be notified on which day you are required to enrol and whether it will be on-campus or online.

Please ensure you contact the Student Loans Company prior to enrolment to ensure that you have sufficient student finance to cover your tuition fees for 2020/21. Please note for funding purposes and in line with our achievement expectations, you are required to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance, be it online or on-campus.
