WHAT WILL TEACHING LOOK LIKE?

You will access your course via an online easy to access learning platform called EQUAL. You find all learning material and assessment feedback on here with 24/7 access allowing you to plan your own learning at a time and a place that suits you. You will work with an allocated tutor who will provide guidance and support and work with you to agree completion dates.

If you need additional learning support remotely, a member of our team will also be available to help online.

Fees

Our Level 1 and 2 online learning courses are free and you will be fee assessed before being enrolled on the course. To be eligible for government funding you need to meet the following criteria:

- Must be aged 19 and over as of 31/08/21
- If aged 19-23, you must hold a full Level 2 qualification or above (five GCSEs, grade A-C/9-4, two AS Levels, one A Level, NVQ Level 2, First Certificate or Principle of Learning Level 2).
- If aged 24+ no qualifications are required
- A resident in the UK for the last three years
- > Not enrolled in any other distance learning course with us

Please note that if a learner withdraws before completing the course they may be charged a £100 admin fee.

Free Level 3 Qualifications for Adults living in London. We can provide learners 19+ with access to their first full Level 3 qualification for FREE, our dedicated team can discuss the criteria with you.

We advise that you only apply for one course using our online form and one of our staff will be in contact following your application to go through with you further what is required and to make sure you are enrolled into the right course for you.
