Assessment:

Learners will complete a series of assessment questions throughout the course. These will be submitted via the online learning platform, EQUAL, and marked by the tutor.

Feedback will be returned to the learner for each assessment they complete.

Entry Requirements:

This course is ideal for anyone who wishes to develop an in-depth knowledge of behaviour that challenges. Anyone who currently works in education or health and social care settings would also benefit from the course.

Financial eligibility:

- Must be aged 19 or over.
- A resident in England for the last 3 years.
- Not enrolled in any other distance learning course with us.
- Not have already done the course of interest before.

Other relevant information:

- The Awarding body is TQUK.
- Certificates are sent as E-certificates.
- It can take 8 - 12 weeks for a learner to receive their certificate once they have completed their course.
