Assessment:

Learners will complete a series of assessment questions throughout the course. These will be submitted via the online learning platform, EQUAL, and marked by the tutor. Feedback will be returned to the learner for each assessment they complete.

This course has a practical element in Unit 1. Learners can demonstrate Key Counselling Skills in a short simulated video or provide a witness testimony. The witness must hold a relevant Counselling qualification higher than Level 2. Please contact us for more information about completing this assessment.

Entry Requirements:

This course does not qualify learners to practice as a counsellor, but is suitable for those who wish to increase their understanding of counselling skills and techniques in order to engage in helpful interaction appropriately. The knowledge gained from this course could be used to complement an existing role, or as a basis for continued study to attain a qualification in this sector.

Financial eligibility:

- Must be aged 19 or over.
- A resident in England for the last 3 years.
- Not enrolled in any other distance learning course with us.
- Not have already done the course of interest before.
