It is made up of six mandatory units as follows:

- Communication and social interaction with individuals with autism
- Safeguarding and resilience in autism.

Assessment:

You will be assessed throughout your study by a series of assessment questions which are built into the course. Your answers are automatically saved and are available for you to revise and edit at any point before submission. You submit your assessment answers to your Tutor for marking, who will give you feedback on each question.

Entry Requirements:

Although there are no formal entry requirements for the distance learning Level 3 Certificate in Understanding Autism course, due to the nature and course delivery, all applicants will be required to take an English and Mathematics assessment, regardless of previous qualifications. You must achieve a Level 2 in English and at least Level 1 Mathematics to be accepted on this course.

Financial eligibility:

- You must be aged 19 years or over on 31st August
- Must have lived in the UK or EEA for the last three years
- You must not already hold a full Level 3 qualification (e.g. four AS Levels or two A Levels etc)
- Learner must not be completing any other funded courses such as an Apprenticeship or any other Distance Learning course

- This is course is delivered via distance learning, each unit will have a set deadline allowing you to plan your study time to fit in with these dates.
