- Students that have declared a learning difficulty, disability and/or health condition on FE, ESOL, HE, Apprenticeships and Access courses
- Learners with an Education, Health and Care plan

## Support includes:

- One to one or small group support with their study program including English and Maths
- In-class or out of class support
- Drop-in support for English, Maths and vocational subjects
- Assessments for Exam Access Arrangements
- Reasonable adjustments to facilities, resources and procedures to enable the student to access their curriculum
- Access to specialist staff that provide direct or indirect input for learners with specific learning difficulties
- Access to quiet study spaces
- Access to assistive technology and equipment
- Information, advice and guidance for career progression
- 19+ and ESOL support available
