Croydon College offers a wealth of courses at all levels to suit everyone. All students need good English and maths skills to be successful in studying, and for future employment, so Croydon College ensures these skills are developed in all learning opportunities.



COURSE LEVELS

Entry Level - this level is ideal for those who don't have any formal qualifications and need to focus on foundation skills **Level 1** - this level is for those with one or two GCSEs who need to focus on foundation skills and learning some of the basics. Most will progress to Level 2 to get qualified for their career.



Level 2 - this is the most commonly studied level and will provide you with the qualifications for employment. You can progress to Level 3 or an Apprenticeship. **Level 3** - this level is equivalent to A levels and is more advanced. On completion you can go onto university, higher apprenticeships or into employment.

Levels 4, 5 and 6

are degree level and are offered at Croydon University Centre on the same campus as the College.
