This event was primarily focused on maths skills and teamwork competing against 7 different colleges, to face the maths challenge. At 11 am, Martin Newton announced the rules and explained the scoring. The first activity was assigned to match the maths questions to the solutions and given 20 minutes to complete the puzzle set. The Go Forth Team (Croydon College) beat the time record of other colleges.

The second activity was the Kahoot quiz, which was the main activity that had the most points, so the team could earn more. Each group worked hard and made a good effort. Now the Go Forth Team has officially won the final, and the members of the team received gold medals and a trophy to represent the victory for Croydon College.

CROYDON COLLEGE WILL BE HOSTING A NEW T LEVEL COURSE.

DIGITAL PRODUCTION, DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT

This T Level programme has been developed in collaboration with employers and businesses, so everything you will learn meets the needs of industry and prepares you for work.

The qualification is structured into 2 component parts:

- Core component you will acquire knowledge of underpinning concepts, theories and principles as well as core skills in: Problem solving (Computational thinking, Algorithms, Program Data, Moral and Ethical issues, emerging technology and trends, Legislation and the digital environment)
- Occupational specialism: Software development with an employee set project set on the development life-cycle of a digital project. Subjects you will cover include Business context, Culture, Data analysis, Digital business environments, Diversity & inclusion, Security protocols and Legislation.
